

JSC SCHOLARS JEWISH STUDENT CONNECTION TEEN MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

A very limited number of merit scholarships (up to \$500 each) are available for Chicago-area high school students who are planning to participate in life-changing Jewish experiences that begin anytime between Fall 2023 - Summer 2024. The goals of the scholarship program are for participants to increase their Jewish identity and have a greater commitment to the Chicago Jewish community.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Demonstrate evidence of leadership, range of community service and involvement (either Jewish or secular, or both), and the potential impact of your Jewish teen program.
- School-year based program scholarships are open to applicants in 9th-12th grade, summer program scholarships are open to applicants in 9th-11th grade.
- Attended at least 25% of JSC clubs at their school during the most recent school year. If your school does not have a
 JSC club, fulfillment of this requirement will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Post-program Expectations:

- Scholarship recipients must continue to attend the JSC club at their school during the following school year, maintaining at least a 25% attendance rate. If there is no JSC club, fulfilling this requirement will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- Write a 400-500 word blog post about your experience in the program for the JSC newsletter, website and more.
- With the help of the club's Advisor, create a program to run at the recipient's JSC club on a topic or place they learned about or experienced during their program.
- Meet with JSC mentor twice to discuss fulfillment of the above expectations.
- Following the first meeting with the JSC mentor, serve as an ambassador for Jewish Student Connection at the recipient's school and in the Chicago Jewish community.

Additional Information:

- Scholarships are awarded by the Scholarship Committee of Jewish Student Connection, a program of the JCC. Final
 decisions are based on the Committee's assessment of the leadership qualities and commitment to service
 demonstrated by the applicants.
- 2. The Scholarship Committee will make the final decisions on the awarding of scholarships. Remember that this is only an application and that no guarantee or promise of receiving a scholarship can be made until the Committee reaches its decision.
- 3. Please understand that funds for scholarships are limited and that not all of the excellent applicants can receive scholarships.
- 4. Notifications of merit scholarship awards will be sent VIA EMAIL.
- 5. Scholarship recipients will receive a check made payable to the Jewish teen program named on the scholarship application. If there is a change of program, please notify JSC office promptly.
- 6. You may seek additional funding from your teen program, your congregation, the Jewish Federation's scholarship program, or any other sources which may be available to you.
- 7. The balance of fees due to the program is you and your family's personal responsibility. If you fail to complete the program, you and your family will have to repay any JSC scholarship award to the Jewish Student Connection.
- 8. You must apply to an approved teen program before you are eligible to apply for a JSC scholarship. You can, however, apply for a scholarship before you have been ACCEPTED to the teen program.
- You may only receive a merit scholarship once. Applicants who apply for but do not receive a scholarship may reapply.
- 10. We ask that you provide any other information that you think would be helpful to us in making our evaluation of your application. Remember, however, this scholarship is not based on financial need.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The JSC Scholars application process has two parts: an application and a recommendation.

- A. The application. All materials must be legible and submitted on time. Applications which are incomplete, hard to read, late, or completed by anyone other than the applicant (except for the recommendation form) will not be considered.
 - 1. The application form and activities sheet. Page one of the application must be signed by both the applicant and a parent or guardian.
 - 2. A brief essay (one to two pages double spaced) on one of the following topics:
 - i. What Jewish value or tradition do you believe has shaped you the most as a person?
 - ii. What do you think is the most pressing issue facing Jewish teens today? Please note that there are no right or wrong answers, we are simply looking for your insight.
- B. Two recommendations reflecting the range of activities, service involvement and leadership abilities.
 - The recommendations can be from a teacher, rabbi, activity sponsor, youth group leader, coach, employer, etc.
 - Do not submit recommendations from family, friends or peers.
